With increasing developments in technology, mental health professionals are finding an increasing need in the utilization of different forms of technology (e-mail, texting, phone, etc.). However, many mental health professionals are not completely aware of professional standards, guidelines, and laws relevant to the use of emailing and texting with clients. This workshop will not only focus on the professional standards, guidelines, and laws relevant to technology in regular mental health practice but also enhance the mental health professional's appropriate daily use of these technologies in their work. This discussion will also focus on the growing importance of security in technology in order to protect the client's confidentiality consistent with HIPAA regulations.

Kenneth Drude, Ph.D. is a psychologist in private practice. He currently serves on the Ohio Board of Psychology and is a past president of the Board. He has participated in the development of telemental health standards and guidelines in Ohio and nationally. He is currently a member of the American Telemedicine Association and the Communications and Technology Committee of the Ohio Psychological Association.

Jon Elhai, Ph.D., is currently Professor in the Department of Psychology at the University of Toledo. His areas of research include examining a) posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD), involving assessment, diagnostic, comorbidity, and mechanistic issues in PTSD; and b) the impact of computer technology on behavior, involving anxiety about internet hacking and information privacy, protecting one' online data and electronic communications, and problematic internet and smartphone use.
